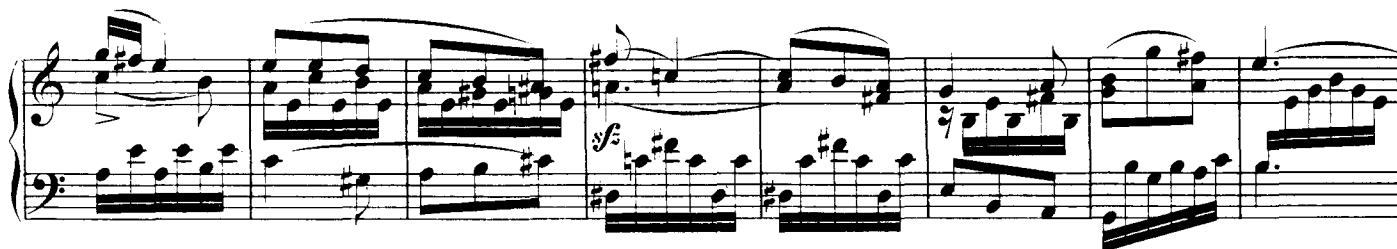


Mendelssohn
